Hello and thank you for your interest in the EmPower New YorkSM program that offers energy efficiency services designed to reduce high energy usage **at no cost** to income-eligible households.

Services are targeted on the basis of energy usage. NYSERDA's mission is to reduce New York's energy use, minimize environmental impact, and maintain energy affordability. Energy efficiency services are delivered by private contractors and are free to the customer.

Measures may include:

- Replacement of old, inefficient refrigerators;
- Installation of high-efficiency lighting;
- Home insulation and air sealing.

To qualify you must:

- Live in a building with 100 residential units or less;
- Be an electric distribution customer of NYSEG, National Grid, Con Edison, or Rochester Gas and Electric;
- Complete and sign the application;
- Provide **one** of the following **income documentations with the application**:
 - a. A copy of a HEAP award letter dated within the past 12 months.
 - b. A copy of a bill from your fuel utility supplier documenting a HEAP payment received within the last 12 months, or documentation of participation in a utility low-income payment assistance program.
 - c. A copy of a Food Stamp award letter or Public Assistance notification in your name received within the last 12 months.
